Dear Sunday School Families,

We have had an excellent start to the religious education instruction of our St. George Youth. We are excited to continue to meet with your children for In-Person catechism lessons at St. George, as well as continue to offer Online instruction via Zoom.

In-Person classes will now be available for children enrolled in PreK3 through grade 12 who will be:

- Attending Liturgy and/or
- Participating in the Dance Troupe practices on Sundays

The In-Person Lessons begin at 11:15 a.m. in the Grand Hall and last for approximately 45 minutes.

Following the Divine Liturgy, students and parents will exit from the front right door of the Chapel. Students are allowed a few minutes break to have a snack, drink water, and use the restrooms prior to class. Snacks and water bottles should be brought from home and finished before entering the Grand Hall for class.

Students ages 9 - 18 are expected to enter the building from the Founders Hall doors and walk towards the Grand Hall on their own. Younger students, ages 3 - 8, should be escorted to the Grand Hall by one adult only. A parent or guardian of preschool students are invited to stay with their child during the class.

Students are expected to wear masks over their nose and mouth during class and will be seated 6 feet apart. No materials will be shared between students in class; sanitized or individually packed material may be distributed by the teachers occasionally to support instruction.

Teachers will be wearing masks as well and hand sanitizer will be available during the class. CDC and St. George Reopening Guidelines outlined in the link below should be followed at all times:
